### Beaufort 47- Llandrindod Wells 20

Llandrindod beat this side in the second round of the Worthington Cup last year but there was not to be a repeat this year.

This was not dour, ground-out Cup match. Instead, spectators were treated to an eight try, fast-moving and committed game, with Beaufort nudging ahead in the try count, but completely eclipsing Llandrindod in the kicking with No. 10 Dylan Smith taking full advantage of Llandrindod's errors to kick 4 penalties and to convert all of their 5 tries, a haul of 22 points, essentially the points difference between the teams.

The sides were fairly evenly matched in the forwards though Llandrindod did have problems in the set pieces. It was in the backs that the difference in the sides was most apparent, though not overwhelmingly so. Experience counted here, and Llandrindod are still on a learning curve. Â

Llandrindod started the match slowly and it was not long before Smith had his side's first points on the board with a penalty. However, it was Llandrindod who scored the first try. A break from scrum-half Dale Wilson, a neat pass to hooker Phil Morgan, and he was over in the corner after 10 metres. Beaufort then took the lead with a Mike Vaughan try, converted by Smith, another Smith penalty and a try from Mathew Ballard, converted by Smith, gave them a dominance at the break, with Llandrindod's sole reply after their try being a Justin Lewis penalty.

Beaufort increased their lead early on in the second half with another Smith penalty but Llandrindod fought back when No.8 Gareth Kinsey took a short pass to score but further quick tries from Beaufort by Elwyn Morgan and Geraint Philips cancelled out any real advantage for the visitors.

Kinsey was in the news again when he wrong-footed the Beaufort defence to touch down under the posts, Lewis converting. Another try for Beaufort, Morgan's second, and yet another penalty for Smith wrapped up the match and Beaufort now go in to the next round.

Llandrindod have no game this weekend due to the International against New Zealand. Their next League game is away against Caerau Ely on 14 November.
